EASY LOVING WHO was close early racing five wide, sustained a bid to be on even terms in deep stretch, battled to the wire and proved best late. HOT FOR YOU was within striking distance early racing off the rail, angled out three wide to rally into the stretch, fought hard to the wire but was outfinished. MY KINDA PRETTY prompted the early pace three wide, vied near the three eighths marker to gain a short lead then weakened in the drive. GERDA'S HOME was unhurried early, circled the field in the turn, went mid track in the stretch and lacked a gain late. PREMEDITATED KATIE was forwardly placed early four wide then tired and gave way. HELLO UNION MILLS was outrun early racing off the inside, drifted out wide near the quarter pole and placed a mild effort while drifting in through the stretch. SHES A LOOKER R F raced mid pack off the rail and lacked a late response. SUNDAY'S GHOST was void of early speed, went four wide and was not a threat. PRINCESS MCKENZY showed little in a dull effort. GO DOM GO showed some early speed drawing clear, was used up early and retreated. JILLY ROO trailed the field and was not a factor.
