**Footnotes**

EMPIRE HOUSE set the early pace saving ground, dueled with SIR STEPHEN in the second turn, edged clear in the stretch and held off closing foe. BERMUDA SUNSET was off slow early, rallied along the rail closing well and was gaining late. OUR STORM was void of early speed, went four wide, vied nearing the eighth pole six wide then flattened. TACO BILLY was within striking distance early racing off the rail, placed a brief bid at the quarter pole then weakened. POWERFUL PETE raced mid pack, shuffled back down the backstretch then showed some effort late along the inside. SIR STEPHEN prompted the early pace from the outside, moved up to duel down the backstretch and was finished early. DIXIE MOUNTAIN chased the early leader racing off the rail then faded steadily after a quarter. CANCEWALK showed little in a dull effort. OUR TRUCK saved ground to no avail.
