PARELLIS VALOR was unhurried early, went four wide splitting foes in the turn, gained steadily through the stretch and prevailed. TRAVIS WEAVER chased the early leader off the inside, drifted five wide into the stretch and was outfinished. DAGGER TATTOO was forwardly placed early four wide, drifted six wide near the three sixteenths but didn't have enough late. WILD TONY set the early pace drawing quickly clear racing off the inside, drifted out wide into the stretch then tired and weakened. SUGARBUGA was allowed to settle early along the inside and placed a mild bid. SPRING ROCKS raced mid pack four wide and lacked a late response. DOUBLE LUCKY WHO was within striking distance early then began to fade steadily. CACTUS COWBOY saved ground to no avail.
