FAVORITE FLAG drew quickly clear angling in to save ground and held a safe advantage throughout. MISS B. G. was forwardly placed early along the inside, lost ground into the turn, then angled out three wide near the quarter pole to place a bid and was clearly the best of the rest. EIGHTY SEVEN prompted the early pace, sustained a brief bid nearing the quarter pole then flattened in the drive but held the show. AMBERS PRIDE was outrun early racing off the rail, showed some interest late splitting foes five wide. ANDJUSTICEFORALL was within striking distance early racing three wide, made a move mid way then weakened. PLUM FAST was unhurried early, closed the gap, drifted out wide in the stretch and went evenly late. TERAS BABY raced mid pack and lacked a late response. FEISTY MISS retreated while saving ground and was vanned off after pulling up. GHOSTLY PRINCESS showed little in a dull effort. BARCELONA BABE failed to threaten.
