CONTRACTOR C was well back early racing four wide, circled the field in the turn, closed with a rush and got up in the final strides. RATE RIDGE forced the early pace, sustained a bid to gain the lead then dueled briefly but was outfinished by a fast closing rival. IRON AXE moved up along the rail to set the early pace, drifted three wide in the stretch and weakened. MARION'S JEWELL was within striking early racing four wide and lacked a gain late. NEARLY WAS MINE made a move mid way four wide then flattened. MATAGOT was off slow early and placed a mild bid late. CHRISTIANS SPECIAL was outrun early saving ground, made a bid move in the turn then gave way. SHOWTIME MAN showed little in a dull effort. CLASSIC FUTURE was forwardly placed between foes then dropped back and was eased to the wire.
