AMBERS PRIDE stalked the early leaders racing off the rail, angled three wide to rally in the stretch and surged clear in the final yards. GOSSIP DOME was unhurried early, went four wide in the stretch and closed well late. D CAT'S TRIP forced the early pace from the outside, vied to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole then tired and gave way. LA LA LA DANDY was allowed to settle early, went four wide and placed a mild effort late. A PENNY LANE lacked early speed along the inside and failed to respond. COLORS OF POMPEII set the early pace angling in along the rail, dueling briefly and was finished early. MANES was off slow early, trailed the field and was always outrun.
