PARTLEY FOGGY chased the early leader, was well rated down the backstretch, sustained a bid nearing the quarter pole, dueled to nearing the wire and was best late. LA SOBRINA set the early pace, drew clear along the inside, drifted off the inside into the stretch, dueled to the wire and was outfinished. GOING WEST GAL was unhurried early racing off the inside, drifted out near the quarter pole five wide and gained the show. PRECIOUS BAY QUEEN was off slow early, was forced six wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. FLAME TO FAME dropped back, saved ground and was not a factor.
