LIL MO MONEY set the early pace along the inside, dueled throughout with JUPITER MAXIMUS, battled in deep stretch then dug in and prevailed at the wire. JUPITER MAXIMUS pressed the early pace then dueled from the outside into the stretch, fought hard to the wire in a game try but was outfinished. TWO SCOTCH BLUES was unhurried early, placed a steady effort, angled three wide into the stretch and finished well to gain the show. WALDO was forwardly placed early between rivals, placed a brief bid into the turn then weakened. SOUTHWEST BOUND broke slow then saved ground gradually closing the gap, angled between foes and placed a mild effort. TURNING TABLES raced mid pack and lacked a late response. RUNNINFORTHEMONEY was unhurried early, went between foes and lacked a bid. BUBBATONE tracked the early leaders then began to retreat steadily after a quarter. SILVER CHANGER failed to threaten. STORMIN T K dropped back was never asked and distanced.
