JACK'S BAND chased the early leaders three wide, sustained a bid nearing the quarter pole, gained the advantage five wide at the eighth pole and held sway to the wire. WAYMORE'S BLUES was off slow early, closed the gap four wide rallied into the stretch, altered out near the eighth pole for running room but didn't have enough late. COW PUNCHIN CASEY was outrun early, advanced steadily into the stretch, went four wide late and was along for the show. TRICK RYDER was hustled away to set the early pace, drew clear briefly at the quarter pole then came up empty in the stretch. FLY LESTER FLY pressed the early pace from the outside, tired after a half and weakened. SCOOBA DE tracked the early leaders while saving ground and lacked a late effort. MR. BAND TIME was allowed to settle early, lost ground into the turn then improved his position in the stretch. RADCLIFFE MAN raced mid pack off the inside then gave way. BLANTONS failed to threaten.
