GOTTA MOVE broke sharp at the break then chased the leader four wide, sustained a bid to edge clear and held gamely. MAKENNA'S GOLD was unhurried early, went four wide then angled out six wide in the stretch and closed well late. DASH TA FAME was within striking distance early along the rail, rallied in the stretch and gained the show. GODZIA was outrun early, went five wide and showed some interest late. QUINSTARGOLD set the early pace drawing clear, raced off the inside then angled three wide in the stretch and weakened. SKARTOON was forwardly placed early five wide then tired and faded. ONESTEPATIME raced mid pack between foes and lacked a late response. KING'S ON TOP was void of early speed racing off the inside, drifted out in the stretch and was not a threat. SILVER NIGHT broke slow at the start, veered outward entering the main track, then settled angling in four wide and was not a factor.
