LOUIE'S BROTHER forced the early pace racing off the inside, began to rally into the stretch, lacked room when CASH SOURCE drifted out, began to alter outward then GUY HUSTON drifted in bumping him, recovered then came with a game effort to get up at the wire. CASH SOURCE set the early pace three wide, drew clear into the second turn, began to drift out in deep stretch, failed to last and was outfinished. GUY HUSTON was within striking early racing four wide, moved up to place a bid into the second turn, drifted in from left handed pressure in deep stretch bumping LOUIE'S BROTHER then yielded. GO BLAKERS GO was unhurried early, saved ground throughout and showed some effort late. TIMPANI was allowed to settle early, went five wide and lacked a late response. SILVERADO STRIKE was outrun early racing off the rail, swung out six wide near the three sixteenths and improved his position. DAZZY SUZZET was off slow and failed to threaten. SIB saved ground to no avail.
