ZTRAVA GANZA set the early pace from the outside racing four wide down the backstretch, edged clear into the stretch three wide and was kept to task. GOSSIP DOME stalked the early leaders four wide, sustained a bid in the late going and was gaining. BASIN ST. HEIRESS forced the early pace while saving ground then weakened in the drive. QUEEN OF BRACKEN was unhurried early along the inside and lacked a closing rally. MONEYINPARENTHESSES was off slow early, went five wide making a move mid way then faded. VENUS AVENUE was allowed to settle early four wide then dropped back and was not a threat.
