DEITY was allowed to settle early, angled out five wide nearing the five sixteenths, rallied into the stretch closing fast and was just up. DESERT GULCH was unhurried early, loomed up to duel with BIG TIME PLAYER into the stretch, fought hard but was outfinished by a fast closing rival. BIG TIME PLAYER pressed the early pace, was challenged down the backstretch, yielded briefly then battled back into the stretch dueling with DESERT GULCH but was denied nearing the wire. HASTY CONCEPT was off slow early racing off the inside, vied nearing the quarter pole, drifted out late in the stretch and flattened. JUST ALITTLE BEAD was within striking distance early four wide then tired and gave way. K O JUSTICE set the early pace saving ground, was used up early and drifted out late fading. CASE FILE was forwardly placed early between foes, sustained a brief bid down the backstretch then weakened. SUPER DEVON trailed the field and was always outrun. There was a Stewards Inquiry and after reviewing the films it was determined there would be no change.
