SAFE TRIP moved up between rivals to set the early pace four wide, edged clear into the turn, drifted out at the top of the stretch racing six wide and held sway. JAM'N JACKSON prompted the early pace four wide, drifted out six wide and lacked a gain late but held the place. IMCO SPIRIT (IRE) was unhurried early racing well off the inside, fanned eight wide near the three sixteenth and lacked a closing rally. MR. TRIESTE was well back early racing off the inside, angled in to save ground in the turn then passed a tiring foe in the stretch. COWBOY'S PRAYER was forwardly placed early saving ground, drifted out in the stretch, was eased to the wire and walked off.
