ISN'T HE CLEVER pressed the early pace from the inside, sustained a bid to duel into the stretch, dug in the final furlong and kicked clear. BRICK MAKER set a pressured early pace from the outside, was challenged into the stretch, dueled to the eighth pole and failed to match strides with the winner. FLAME BROILED forced the early pace from between foes, dropped back near the five sixteenths then came back in the stretch for the show. SUN COUNTRY was unhurried early, made a brief bid three wide in the turn then weakened. RAMBLIN CADDEN was off slow, saved ground and failed to threaten.
