MAYBE TO FAST showed early speed drawing clear, drifted out stretch, was never seriously challenged and proved best. MY PICASSO forced the early pace from the outside, then chased the leader in the stretch and lacked a gain. AFFLUENT BOY bobbled leaving the gate, was steadied then settled into stride, swung out seven wide into the stretch and showed some effort late to gain the place. DODSON raced mid pack five wide, altered in three wide mid stretch and lacked a rally. EIGHTNCHANGEEROOM was close early along the rail then faded in the stretch. LANE STORMER was outrun racing off the rail and was not a factor. ELIJAH'S ELITE saved ground to no avail.
