GHOSTLY FLY was off slow early racing four wide, gained ground into the second turn, rallied five wide, battled to the wire with STICKEM and prevailed. STICKEM was outrun early five wide, moved up steadily into the second turn, bid six wide in the stretch, fought hard to the wire but missed. TEJANO CAT stalked the leaders from along the inside, vied into the second turn to gain a short lead, was challenged in deep stretch, dug in but faltered in the final yards. PACHE ECHO STAR was unhurried early, loomed up four wide near the five sixteenths then weakened. MIKEY TOO set the early pace while saving ground and was finished after a half. BUSHY GEORGE showed little in a dull effort. SOME KIND OF LUCK raced mid pack along the rail then faded steadily. GRANNY'S SONG pressed the early pace from the outside and was finished early.
