DANCE BEFOREASTORM was allowed to settle early, rallied four wide at the top of the stretch, responded well when asked and surged clear. PURE RED HEAD dropped back early five wide, loomed up seven wide, closed willingly but was no match for the winner. ILIMITADO was unhurried early along the inside, angled out between foes at the top of the stretch and showed some effort late. LAVISPA stalked the early leaders racing off the inside and lacked a gain late. R LA PATRONA prompted the early pace saving ground then gave way. MYSTERIOUS CARGO drew quickly clear, was challenged, dueled briefly, was used up early and stopped.
