**Footnotes**

QUINSTARGOLD showed early speed drawing quickly clear, was never challenged and much the best. CATCH THE KING was unhurried early saving ground, angled between foes in the turn, split foes into the stretch and showed some effort late. I SEE RED was forwardly placed early, went five wide to place a bid at the top of the stretch then went evenly late. TITANIUM HALO was allowed to settle early, rallied circling the field then flattened in the drive. STARTINGTIME was within striking distance early, sustained a brief bid then weakened. I'MGOINGI'MGONE was off slow early, went four wide into the stretch and placed a mild bid. KING OF THE DANCE was off slow early, went seven wide and improved his position. EROS EISHIN was outrun early, went six wide and lacked a rally. FLASHY RED ODD'S showed little in a dull effort. YOAKUMCOUNTYKID was well back early racing five wide and was not a threat. NIGHT VICTOR failed to menace. TRICKY BATTLE showed some brief speed along the inside then stopped.
