OCEANOR set the early pace, gained a clear advantage, was challenged in deep stretch, held off a closing rival in the final strides and just lasted. LAWTON'S BREEZE was outrun early four wide, began to close the gap into the second turn, found his best stride late and missed in the final yards. FLEETING SUMMER chased the early leaders while saving ground, angled out four wide in the stretch and finished well enough to gain the show. NEW STUFF tracked the early leader, was finished early and weakened in the lane. SEA MONSTER was off slow early and lacked a closing response along the rail. CACTUS COWBOY raced mid pack, went four wide and faded in the stretch. HANGMAN'S GULCH was well back early, raced four wide and was not a factor.
