**Footnotes**

REAPER stalked the early leaders four wide, sustained a bid into the stretch, went six wide to duel briefly then dug in and prevailed at the wire. CATAFLYING set the early pace, gained a short lead in the turn, drifted out five wide near the three sixteenths, was challenged nearing the eighth pole, battled gamely but was outfinished. DANDY DON WHO forced the early pace four wide, went between foes in the turn, altered inward near the eighth pole and went evenly thereafter. PLAY DOME was outrun early and sustained a steady gain five wide. CHILI CON QUESO raced mid pack five wide, placed a brief bid then flattened. RIVER CROSSING was unhurried early and lacked a late response. OUTLAW IN TOWN was allowed to settle early and lacked a late effort. BEAUMONT TIME broke inward at the break to get away slow and lacked a rally. POBLANO was never far back early saving ground, angled four wide and faded. QUICK TIME was forwardly placed early racing off the rail and gave way. DONTCHACALLNOMO went six wide and retreated steadily. FONZERELLI was taken up down the backstretch and vanned off.
