Footnotes

SALT BOX forced the early pace from the inside, sustained a bid then dueled with GOLD ASURE into deep stretch and inched away nearing the wire. GOLD ASURE set the early pace drawing clear briefly, then was headed by SALT BOX, dueled into deep stretch and was outfinished. CRAFTY SHEIK was within striking distance racing well off the rail, rallied in the stretch seven wide and showed some late effort to gain the show. GHOST SMASHER forced the early pace, then settled into stride and lacked a gain late. LATENITE COWBOY broke outward at the start then chased the leaders racing off the rail and weakened. GONE PACK N was off slow early and placed a mild bid late. YNOTME raced mid pack, angled out into the stretch six wide and went evenly late. JARETT'S CAT broke slow at the start and failed to menace. BLUE EYED CAT failed to sustain a bid. EXCESSIVE LANE showed little and was not a factor.
