SENIOR SONORA was outrun early saving ground, closed the gap along the rail, angled out at the top of the stretch three wide, closed well drawing clear and widened. SIPOWITZ was unhurried early saving ground, angled out four wide finished well and gained the place. STEAM ROLLIN BLUES was void of early speed, placed a rally and was along for the show three wide. H. E.'S FAST set a pressured early pace between foes, dueled into the stretch and gave way. SLEW THE GOLD prompted the early pace saving ground, placed a bid to duel into the stretch then weakened. SUPER DOME forced the early pace three wide then retreated. COUNTING SHEEP raced mid pack and stopped in the stretch.
