IRON AXE was allowed to settle along the inside, sustained a bid in deep stretch to make a big move on the rail then surged clear. SOMEKINDA ROSE set the early pace racing off the rail, drifted three wide in the stretch and failed to last. RATE RIDGE chased the early leader, rallied between foes in the stretch three wide then yielded. DON'T LOOK TWICE was unhurried early, went five wide and showed some interest late. CATCHDAGENT was forwardly placed early five wide then weakened. CHAPEL OF ROSES was outrun early, went six wide and sustained a mild effort. GOING WITH HOUSTON was void of early speed along the inside and improved his position in the stretch. WHOS GAMBLING NOW failed to threaten. CLASSIC FUTURE showed little in a dull effort.
