OUR FLYING ANGEL stalked the early leaders five wide, sustained a bid to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole then inched away and proved best. HOT FOR YOU was unhurried early, rallied in the stretch six wide, closed willingly and was gaining. QUINTON'S DOLL WHO set the early pace racing off the inside, was challenged then dueled into the stretch, faltered in the final furlong but held the show. GERDA'S HOME was allowed to settle early, rallied four wide and showed some effort late. SANDIA SONATA lacked early speed, placed a brief bid into the stretch then went evenly late. EASY LOVING WHO raced mid pack, was wide in the stretch and placed a mild bid. DASHKOVA was outrun and showed little. GARRETSGHOSTLYGIRL forced the early pace three wide and was finished early. SUPER STORMY was void of early speed, went four wide late and lacked a bid. BEV'S FAST LANE chased the early leaders off the inside then faded steadily. ROLL BLOOMERS ROLL broke slow at the start, saved ground early, drifted out mid track in the stretch and was not a factor. MOONFACE was forwardly placed early then retreated steadily.
