DANGEROUS DEVON was the early speed, kicked clear at the sixteenth pole and pulled away in the final yards. ROJO TORO was the early speed between, bid five to six wide and battled gamely to hold second. IZA RIGHTEOUS DUDE was unhurried, bid 4wide and was gaining between. ESTEBAN MIGUEL vied inside, was in tight on the rail at the eighth pole and could not sustain bid. PRIMARY SUSPECT showed early speed between, vied four wide and flattened. CAJUN PEPPER was forwardly placed and was thru early. RUN AT NIGHT had a rail trip and was no factor.
