Footnotes

S D S GOLDEN BOY raced in the second flight from inside, angled out some on the turn, in path four entering the lane, drifted out some as he took over upper stretch, moved clear, was all out the last eighth and held off GHOSTLY DUDE. GHOSTLY DUDE in midpack from outside, was four wide on the bend, altered outside S D S GOLDEN BOY upper stretch, lugged in some with a furlong left, altered back outside the latter, closed well but was too late. DEVON'S SHADOW broke outward, was corrected, advanced between horses on the turn, five wide into the lane then was forced to angle in then back out trying to gain a clear path to advance. WHAT'DHESAY contested the pace from outside, floated out to path three entering the stretch, could not stay with S D S GOLDEN BOY and gradually wore down the last eighth. ZIG BULLS WAY in midpack between rivals, came four wide into the stretch then had to alter his path repeatedly. NEW MEXICO KID advanced from inside on the turn, came off the rail some for a clear path in the lane, gained a striking position upper stretch but hung instead. WILSON was soon well back, swung out some leaving the turn, altered outside for room upper stretch then had to alter out again in the late going. LESTER GRAY was away slowly, progressed between rivals then also had to alter his path repeatedly in the lane. SAN PEDROS BABY without speed, had the inside on the turn, floated out to path three into the stretch, was forced to alter his path several times and bumped hard with COMIC

SMARTY CAT in the waning yards. MOURAMOR was sent to contest the pace from inside but flattened out for the drive. COMIC SMARTY CAT ran in the second flight from outside, failed to keep up entering the lane, angled out some upper stretch, gave way, lugged in late and bumped hard with SAN PEDROS BABY. MOORE BULL crowded just after the break, was steadied, trailed from inside, angled out on the turn, drifted out into the stretch and was empty.
