Footnotes

THATSNOLIE rated just off the early speed from outside, was asked two wide at the top of the stretch, moved clear and continued to lengthen his lead under a drive the last eighth. DIESEL INJUN was kept close from outside, four wide taking the turn, under a drive between horses in the lane and caught SANDIA HARBOR for second late. SANDIA HARBOR set a pressured pace between rivals, had the inside on the bend, proved no match for THATSNOLIE when set down for the drive, weakened late and was outfinished for the place. P. T. CAT broke inward and a step slowly, trailed from outside, angled in nearing the turn, swung back outside on the bend, floated out to path six for the drive and found best stride too late. ME A PACHE was prominent between horses early, swung outside THATSNOLIE on the turn, three wide into the lane, had no late bid but was easily best of the rest. PETRA'S FOLLY was also off a step slowly, three to five wide throughout and failed to menace. HEZA HOT SHOT was angled out trying to gain a clear path early, two to four wide taking the bend and had no late bid. LOOKS STORMY soon overcame an awkward start, pressed from inside but faded on the turn.
