Footnotes

DOS AND DON'TS stalked the early speed from between horses, moved to the outside into the bend, came four wide entering the lane, responded to mild urging, moved clear and maintained control ridden out. VINNY V. prominent between horses, took the inside into the turn, battled for second in the stretch and narrowly held his position. PRINCE CARSON pressed from outside, three wide taking the bend, fought for second through the lane but did not have enough late. ABSOLUTELY TRUE fought the rider briefly at the start, showed no speed, was just off the inside on the turn, swung out five wide for the stretch run and made up minor ground in the waning yards. WIND WATER was hustled up to the lead from inside, floated out a bit entering the turn, stayed just off the inside and wore down for the drive. IMPERIAL OFFICER was away slowly, soon well back, saved ground taking the bend and lacked a significant stretch response.
