Footnotes

DOUBLE SMART chased the early leaders three wide, vied angling in to save some ground, lacked room at the eighth pole, shifted out to go around ENCHANTED OUTLAW in the final yards and finished with a late surge to just get up. ENCHANTED OUTLAW forced the early pace three wide, gained a clear advantage into the second turn, held to nearing the wire and was denied by a fast closing foe. RUNNIN RED was unhurried early, moved up down the backstretch four wide, was within striking at the top of the stretch then went evenly late. BROTHER JOHN D. was off slow early racing five wide, rallied between foes in the stretch and showed some effort late. DESERT GAMBLE was outrun early, sustained a brief bid into the stretch then flattened. SOME GHOST raced mid pack saving ground and lacked a gain late. SPINNING TOUCH was void of early speed and showed some effort late between foes. SILVER MATTHAIS saved ground making a move mid way then faded. HE'S A TOUGH DUDE showed early speed racing off the rail and was finished after a half. BRAX was forwardly placed early, gave way racing wide late. LESTERS SECRET duled from between rivals, was used up early and retreated.
