**Footnotes**

TRAIN RIDER BLUES was off slow early racing seven wide down the backstretch, began to gain ground angling in through the turn three wide, was forced to alter outward near the sixteenth for racing room and closed with a rush to just get up at the wire. HERBAL SLEW set the early pace angling in to save ground, held a safe advantage into the stretch, was challenged nearing the wire, battled gamely but was denied at the wire. CHUCHULUCO was within striking distance early three wide, vied at the top of the stretch four wide, finished willingly with a good effort but was outfinished in the final strides. LESTER'S ECHO tracked the early leader from the inside, sustained a bid nearing the eighth pole then yielded in the final yards. MAYBE TO FAST was allowed to settle early, made a move mid way four wide then flattened in the stretch. EXPLOSIVE MINE was outrun early while saving ground, angled out five wide into the stretch and improved his position late while drifting out. MY PICASSO was unhurried early, rallied five wide into the turn, was fanned eight wide in the stretch and weakened. YVETT'S MAAR raced mid pack, saved ground through out then gave way. SHAZBOT broke slowly to trail the field and was not a factor.
