Footnotes

PREBOOK was slow early, gained steadily to the top of the stretch, vied five wide, was on even terms at the eighth pole then surged clear. PACHE ECHO STAR was forwardly placed early, rallied between foes three wide, gained a short lead at the eighth pole but was outfinished by closing foe. ELEGANT MOVES chased the early leaders, sustained a bid into the stretch, went evenly late but held the show. ROCK RED set the early pace drawing clear into the first turn racing three wide, then tired into the second turn and weakened. MROBNOXIOUS prompted the early pace while saving ground then came up empty in the drive. INIQUITOUS KID was unhurried early and lacked a late response. MANY MOVE was off slow early, went three wide and failed to threaten. FLIPSON dropped back, went four wide and improved his position. SKIPPER DO raced mid pack five wide, retreated steadily and was eased to the wire.
