PERSHING was off slow early racing well off the rail, closed to gap nearing the quarter pole, was the widest into the stretch and wore down his foes and proved best late. CHALLENGER was allowed to settle early, vied three wide to draw clear at the eighth pole and was outfinished in the final yards. BEST YEARS was unhurried early saving ground, placed a mild bid five wide and gained the show. DORITA'S DREAM was void of early speed racing along the inside, lacked room entering the stretch, then altered out splitting foes and showed some late effort when clear. BANKER'S WAY dropped back early racing off the rail and placed a mild bid three wide. QUICK ASSETS chased the early leaders racing five wide then faded. WINGS OF FREEDOM set the early pace while saving ground then retreated in the stretch. HE'S MY DESSERT pressed the early pace, was finished early and stopped.
