CHOCOLATE HEARTS was forwardly placed four wide, drifted out seven wide into the stretch, drifted out again leaving the three sixteenths marker brushing PLANT CITY then closed well when clear and was just up. SECRETLY GOLDEN set the early pace racing off the rail, edged clear into the stretch, dug in the final strides but was denied at the wire. PLANT CITY was allowed to settle early, began to rally into the turn, was forced wide at the quarter pole, then steadied leaving the three sixteenth and finished well with a game try. CLASSY ABBY forced the early pace four wide then flattened in the drive. SUSAN'S VISION was off slow early, saved ground through out and showed some interest late. WAY NO raced mid pack along the inside and lacked a late response. QUEEN TSU was within striking distance early racing along the rail then faded steadily. SECRETARIAT ROCKET broke slowly, went four wide trailing the field and was not a factor. There was an Inquiry and after reviewing the films the Stewards determined there would be no change.
