LEMONBIRD bumped with RODEO CAT at the break, was rated on the front end from inside, let out on the turn, roused with a quarter mile left then opened up under steady urging. I THINK IT IS vied for the early lead between rivals, three wide taking the bend, battled for second in the lane and narrowly held on. FAITHFUL BEAU broke on top and outward, contested the pace toward the outside, angled in some on the turn, came four wide into the lane, fought outside I THINK IT IS to the wire, did not have enough late but was easily best of the rest. DELATORE bumped with TOOLATE AGAIN SAM at the start, dueled for the lead three wide, was just off the inside taking the bend and had no stretch bid. PEDIATRICS displayed early speed between horses but began to fade four wide leaving the turn. RODEO CAT fractious during the loading process, was bumped at the break, steadied, trailed, two or three wide taking the turn, angled out some upper stretch and had little to offer. STONEY RUN also broke outward, was soon taken outside, widest through the turn and was empty for the drive. TOOLATE AGAIN SAM contested the pace two wide, was checked when his path was taken into the bend, altered in and steadily faded.
