REALLY A CHIMES was allowed to settle early three wide, placed a bid responding well, kicked clear and widened in deep stretch. DONEDIGGIN stalked the early leader five wide, vied in the stretch to get up for the place but was no match for the winner. STAR OF KINGS was off slow early, vied five wide in the stretch, was urged strongly in the final yards and got up for the show. GENERAL MANIA was void of early speed and gained steadily six wide. TRADERS TURN forced the early pace from the inside then weakened. LUCKY NORTH STAR was outrun early, went eighth wide at the quarter pole and showed some late effort. FIRE E BEAN was within striking distance racing along the inside, brief bid near the eighth pole, then altered out and yielded. LEA COUNTY LINEMAN lacked a late response. DIAMOND INTHE PUFF set the early pace, was finished after a half and gave way. GETAWAY CAT failed to threaten. WICKED BULL raced mid pack then retreated.
