HIGHEST HUMOR broke sharp, angled in to save ground into the first turn, forcing LAWTON'S BREEZE to steady, also put MINISTER PERFECT in tight quarters into the first turn, went four wide dueled to the top of the stretch then surged clear and held sway. MINISTER PERFECT was in tight quarters into the first turn, settled into stride four wide down the backstretch, moved up while swinging out six wide at the three sixteenth to place a bid but didn't have enough late. GUILTYBYASSOCIATION was within striking distance early, rallied four wide between rivals, dueled briefly then flattened. LAWTON'S BREEZE was steadied into the first turn when HIGHEST HUMOR drifted in entering the first turn, then was unhurried racing five wide. fanned seven wide into the stretch and showed some interest late. BOSS HOGG WHO dropped back early racing four wide and placed a mild bid. BERMUDA SUNSET was outrun early and improved his position in the stretch. NEWTONS THEORY prompted the early pace from between foes, dueled briefly then gave way. BOURBON CAT dueled early along the inside and was finished early. The rider of MINISTER PERFECT claimed interference against the rider of HIGHEST HUMOR and after reviewing the films the Stewards determined there would be no change.
