WAVE THE TAX forced the early pace from the inside, placed a bid into the stretch to gain the advantage, drifted out some late and widened. SILVER THUNDER was outrun in the early going racing off the rail, angled out five wide at the top of the stretch splitting foes and closed well to get up for the place. HE'S A HEATHEN set a pressured early pace between rivals, yielded in the stretch drive but held the show. MONEY DANCE raced mid pack and lacked a rally. GOTTA BEAT EM ALL pressed the early pace from the outside and was finished early. MIKAY AS LADY was close in the early going saving ground then gave way. BABES WONT TELL showed little in a dull effort. EXCESSIVE BEAUTY went six wide at the quarter pole then retreated.
