### Footnotes

SUNDAY SUNRISE was unhurried early racing along the inside, gained ground steadily, slipped thru along the rail at the top of the stretch, dueled briefly with IMCO SPIRIT (IRE) at the eighth pole then surged clear nearing the wire. IMCO SPIRIT (IRE) chased the early leader, vied to gain a clear advantage at the quarter pole, was headed near the eighth pole, dueled briefly but failed to match strides and was outfinished. QUIET AGAIN was allowed to settle early racing three wide, rallied into the second turn then went evenly through the stretch. GOING BALLISTIC was within striking distance early saving ground, angled five wide at the top of the stretch, drifted in steadily and lacked a gain. SKIP A SMILE dropped back early, began to close the gap into the second turn but was never a serious threat. SHIVERS ME set the early pace saving ground and was finished early.
