LOTA TALENT was unhurried early, rallied at the top of the stretch four wide, closed with a rush late and was just up. COSMIC CHI prompted the early pace five wide, vied into the turn, gained a short lead into the stretch, held the advantage to nearing the wire then was outfinished in the final strides. BROTHER LOUIE was allowed to settle early racing off the inside, swung out seven wide in the stretch, closed well but didn't have enough late. FAST A NUFF was void of early speed, gained steadily four wide, drifted in the final sixteenth and showed some effort late. LE GRANDE CHANCE pressed the early pace, dueled into the stretch then gave way along the inside. CITYMAN dueled from between rivals into the turn, then tired and faded. SHUG'S STORM CAT raced mid pack along the inside then weakened. FOURTEEN KT. GOLD was outrun early three wide and lacked a late bid. YVETT'S MAAR was forwardly placed between foes then stopped in the stretch.
