METALLIC MIST set the early pace racing well off the inside four wide, lugged out in the turn, went eight wide at the top of the stretch then drifted in throughout and drew clear. ONETIMEATBANDCAMP stalked the early leaders, placed a bid into the turn, was carried wide into the stretch and didn't have enough when clear. DEL MAR DRAMA was unhurried early, went three wide and placed a mild effort. COASTAL FLASH prompted the early pace four wide then gave way in the lane. REGATTA TONE was off slow early, went four wide and improved his position. RODEO CAT chased the early leaders racing off the rail and lacked a bid. There was a Stewards Inquiry and after reviewing the films it was determined there would be no change.
