Footnotes

INIQUITOUS KID was unhurried early along the inside, sustained a bid to slip thru at the top of the stretch, battled to the wire and inched away to prove best. SKIPPER DO set the early pace drawing clear, was challenged into the stretch, battled gamely to the wire but was outfinished. HIGH RIDGE RUNNER broke inward at the break bumping ANOTHERCHO, then settled into stride four wide between foes, rallied in the stretch and was gaining late. SUPER FRITZ chased the early leader racing off the rail, vied angling out three wide then yielded in the drive. MAGNIFICENT STORM stalked the early leaders three wide, angled out five wide in the stretch and lacked a rally. SMARTY BEAR was off slow early, went six wide down the backstretch and placed a mild effort late. JOLI'S DOME was outrun early racing off the rail and lacked a late response. ANOTHERCHO was bumped at the break racing off the rail and failed to threaten. CRAFTY SHEIK broke outward at the break, raced mid pack, was wide in the stretch and gave way. CHENAULT'S DEPUTY trailed the field and was always outrun.
