Footnotes

GULCHRUNSSWEET broke sharp to draw quickly clear racing off the rail, was challenged nearing the quarter pole, responded to pressured and surged clear in the final strides. CATTLEMAN PROSPECT was allowed to settle early, vied racing four wide near the quarter pole, showed some effort late but didn't have enough and was clearly second best. EL DRAMO was unhurried early, closed the gap along the inside, placed a bid at the top of the stretch to contend briefly with the leader then weakened in the drive. DESERT GAMBLE was well back in the early going racing off the rail, fanned six wide into the stretch and showed some interest late. Z Z DOME raced mid pack five wide and lacked a closing response. CATABOLIZE was off slow, saved ground and showed little. RETSINA SPRING tracked the early leader, sustained a brief bid then faded.
