MR. TRAV set the early pace, was pressured briefly into the turn, then edged clear and was kept to task to the wire. DRAMATIC KING was unhurried early, placed a steady effort in the stretch four wide and gained the place but was not threat to the winner. ENAMORADO was within striking distance early along the inside, sustained a brief bid into the stretch then went evenly late. RAISE A BET was outrun early six wide, angled out seven wide in the stretch to rally with a mild effort. SEVENFIFTYNINE was allowed to settle early saving ground and lacked a closing response. NATHAN'S SPECIAL was off slow early between rivals, drifted out wide in the stretch and improved his position. CACTUS COWBOY saved ground to no avail. GOLD WATCH pressed the pace briefly three wide then faded steadily after a quarter. DIANES SMOKEN GUN was forwardly placed early, went three wide at the quarter pole then gave way.
