CHARM A ROBBER moved up to set the early pace three wide, was challenged nearing the eighth pole, responded to pressure and drew clear. RUNNING IN HEELS broke poorly to get away slow, drifted well off the rail down the backstretch, gained steadily throughout and finished willingly. YOURA was within striking distance early three wide, sustained a bid nearing the quarter pole then drifted five wide in the stretch and weakened. INGRATA MIA forced the early pace from along the inside while saving ground then tired. KNOXVILLE GIN was unhurried early three wide, drifted out six wide in the late going and lacked a gain. LADY SCAT CAT raced mid pack along the rail and lacked a rally. LEO'S BEEN KATTIN was allowed to settle early along the inside then faded steadily. STORMIN SUNSHINE dropped back to trail the field saving ground and was always outrun.
