Footnotes

OMEGA STORM was unhurried early four wide, began to close the gap into the turn, swung out mid track to launch a bid, closed well and was going away. ATLANTIC THUNDER prompted the early pace racing off the inside, gained the lead in mid turn, edged clear in the stretch but was outfinished in the waning yards. SPURR ROAD was allowed to settle early, began to move up between splitting foes, was within striking distance then flattened. STAR PACKER was forwardly placed three wide, angled out seven wide for the drive and lacked a gain. CACTUS COWBOY was never far back saving ground and lacked a late response. LINCOLN COUNTY WAR was outrun early, sustained a mild bid four wide but was no threat. UNTOUCHABLE TODD raced mid pack along the inside and lacked a closing effort. PLANKS STEP was off slow, saved ground and was not a factor. STARTINGTIME was close in the early going four wide and was finished after a half. QUALITY STORM showed some brief speed racing off the inside then retreated. PURGATORY DANCER was reluctant to load, off slow and showed little.
