OCEAN JOE was never far back racing three wide, sustained a bid to kick clear in mid stretch and proved best late. WILDINTHEWILDWEST was unhurried early, vied four wide nearing the quarter pole, was urged steadily in the stretch then flattened in the final going. BOOGER BOO was outrun early, rallied four wide with a mild effort and was along for the show. SLICKUNO broke slow at the start to be well back in the early going, angled in to save ground, closed the gap some into the stretch then went evenly. SHUG'S STORM CAT set the early pace while saving ground was challenged into the stretch then faded in the final sixteenth. JIMSON prompted the early pace from the outside and was finished after a half. SUPER WOOD was outrun early, raced wide throughout and failed to menace. BIRDIE'S GENIUS made a move mid way then retreated. SANTIAGO'S MAGIC tracked the early leaders along the rail then gave way.
