Footnotes

THREE SLEWS was well placed early, rallied into the stretch four wide and drifted in while surging clear. ARTISTIC MOMENT was allowed to settle early along the inside, then closed well in deep stretch to get up for the place. OTISISGOLD was forwardly placed early saving ground, angled out to place a bid, was in contention at the eighth pole then hung in the final going. RUSSIAN LIQUOR was hustled away to draw clear racing three wide, was challenged in deep stretch and yielded. Z STRIKE GOLD prompted the early pace three wide, drifted four wide in the stretch, lacked room late and altered outward but had little left. OUTTA TUNE dropped back early and placed a mild effort late. MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION lacked early speed racing five wide then gave way. IZE ON JUAN raced wide and failed to threaten. SILVER DADDY was outrun early, went four wide and lacked a rally.
