TRUSTEE TOM showed early speed to set the pace, edged clear in the stretch, was full of run late and opened up. BIG DADDY NORMAN was unhurried early racing off the inside, vied into the turn, went five wide in the stretch, finished willingly but was no match for the winner. FRANK AND JESSE was allowed to settle early, closed the gap into the turn to be with striking, went four wide in the stretch and weakened. SECRET ADMIRAL was off slow early, raced off the inside and placed a mild bid late. LEGACY SONG was outrun early, raced wide throughout and passed tiring foes in the stretch. BUBBA WHO was forwardly placed early between rivals the gave way. MAGIC OKIE forced the early pace from the rail, then retreated after a quarter and was eased to the wire.
