**Footnotes**

UNIQUE CRUISE set the early pace from between foes, edged clear in mid stretch and held a safe advantage to the wire. SHOULD was unhurried early, rallied nearing the quarter pole four wide and was gaining late. LITTLE MISS RULER was within striking distance early, sustained a bid to contend with the leader near the quarter pole then weakened in the drive. JOCHEBED prompted the early pace from the inside and lacked a gain late. WEDNESDAYAFTERNOON angled in to save some ground racing mid pack and lacked a closing response. GETINTHEREONETIME was unhurried early, went seven wide and was even late. INDIABONITA was outrun early while saving ground angled out wide into the stretch and improved her position. ROSE IS A RAGE was forced to steady near the nine sixteenth pole when WEDNESDAYAFTERNOON drifted in and was not a factor thereafter. ILIMITADO broke slow at the start, went six wide late and failed to menace. ECLAIR DES CHAMPS pressed the early pace from between foes, was used up early and retreated.
